Paper: UArt sanded pastel paper, or Ampersand Pastel-bord. These surfaces allow you to rework/reapply pastel in multiple layers with some of the materials we will be using. It also holds up to much of the abuse you will give the surface. UArt papers, 320 or 400 grit and Ampersand Pastel-bord are available through Dakota Art Pastels, Dick Blick, Amazon or any online art store. **Sizes**: 9x12, 12x16, 16x20, 18x24

You can also make your own pastel boards using Masonite or gatorboard, and pastel ground by Golden or use Clear Gesso by Liquitex.

Bring the pastels you usually work with. I also bring enough pastels for the class to use. If you don't have enough pastels or don't want to purchase at this time, mine are available for use. Your pastels should include

*a good range of values, Light, Medium, Dark

*a good range of neutral colors warm and cool

* a set of neutral greys

Gloves if you use them. I will have some available if you forget.

Color wheel- I use two color wheels, standard color wheel and Color Harmony wheel.
